# **Transfer Credit Evaluations**

Transfer credit will be evaluated by the Office of Admissions only after admission. As a general rule, course work transferred from an accredited institution earned with a grade of "C" or better (on the Alliant International University grading scale) and comparable to the academic course work offered by Alliant International University will be eligible for transfer to the student's academic program at Alliant International University. Final official transcripts are required to prepare transfer credit evaluations.

# How to Apply

It is important that you provide all the necessary documents in order to process your application for admission as an international student to Alliant International University. Please check the following list to make sure you have included everything needed for your enrollment:

- 1. A completed application.
- 2. A nonrefundable application fee of \$45 ( bank draft or personal check drawn from a U.S. bank or international money order) is required to cover the cost of processing the application materials.
- 3. You must submit official, translated transcripts and results from a foreign educational credential evaluation service agency. The evaluation must contain the following:
  - U.S. semester credit and grade equivalent for each course
  - U.S. grade point average

- 4. The minimum grade point average (GPA) requirement for undergraduate admission is a cumulative of 2.0 on a 4.0.
- 5. The Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) and/or the Test of Written English (TWE) are required for non-native speakers. Students whose native language is not English or who have not earned an undergraduate or graduate degree from an accredited U.S. higher education institution are required to show English proficiency by taking the TOEFL. Alliant also requires a minimum score of 5 or higher on the TWE. Please contact TOEFL directly to request an official score report; Alliant's TOEFL code is 4039.
- 6. Complete the Financial Certification Form in this application, and provide an original bank letter showing cash availability and/or letter of sponsorship, as appropriate in your case. No photocopies of financial certification documents will be accepted.

The form must be completed with the student's and sponsor's signature. This requirement does not apply to permanent residents (resident aliens). Students accompanied by other family members must certify additional U.S. funds per year for each dependent. 7. A transfer verification form (if student is presently attending an institution in the United States). DHS (Department of Homeland Security) regulations require that you maintain full-time student status while in the U.S. on a student visa.

Alliant reserves the right to require further certification of finances or advance payment of tuition and fees from students whose funds originate in countries where severe currency restrictions exist.

**IMPORTANT:** International students must present satisfactory evidence of adequate funds available to meet financial obligations at Alliant International University. Our office will not be able to issue you an I-20 to obtain a student visa until this form is received.

All international student applicants who wish to attend Alliant International University must submit proof of financial support for their studies while in the United States. International students must NOT depend on working either on or off campus any time during their stay in the United States. Students must consider such factors as inflation and foreign exchange fluctuations when figuring the total cost of study.

U.S. Immigration regulations require international students to be enrolled full-time for a minimum of two semesters each year. Two semesters are equal to nine months. Students have the option to enroll for the winter intersession, or a third semester in the summer. Undergraduate tuition is \$7,440 per semester (12 units for full-time status). Room and board is \$9,878 for the 9-month contract for double occupancy. Costs for additional classes beyond the stated full-time status or for single occupancy rooms are the responsibility of the student and funds will accordingly need to be available. Average costs for two semesters are below. They may vary depending on program requirements.

#### **Government Sponsors**

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# **FINANCIAL AID**

# How to Apply

It's very important to apply for federal and state financial aid every year, as early as possible. You do not have to wait until you are accepted to college. Use the FAFSA, the Free Application for Federal Student Aid, for both federal and state aid. You can apply online at http://www.fafsa.ed.gov where you will be able to review your application status online, as well as sign your application electronically with a PIN.

You must indicate your college choices on the FAFSA: Alliant's FAFSA code is 011117.

## Deadlines

The priority deadline to apply for Financial Aid is March 2. (For federal financial aid, file as soon as possible after January 1, in the year that you wish to enroll. You have until midnight June 30 of the following year to postmark your paper application. However, if you also want to receive aid from the State of California, you must turn in your FAFSA and the GPA verification form no later than March 2.)

# Eligibility

A student is eligible for financial aid if he or she:

- Is a U.S. citizen, or eligible non-citizen
- Is not in default on a federal student loan or has made satisfactory repayment arrangements
- Does not owe money on a federal student grant or has made satisfactory repayment arrangements
- Is registered with Selective Service (males at least 18 years old)
- Has a valid social security number
- Is enrolled at Alliant (in at least six units per semester, 12 units for some aid such as Perkins) in a degree program
- Is making Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP)

# **Processing your Application**

Once Alliant receives your FAFSA data electronically from the Department of Education, we calculate a standard budget for you. The standard budget includes full-time tuition (12-16 units) and average living expenses (housing status: on campus, off campus, or with parents).

The Financial Aid Package is compiled based on the results of your Student Aid Report (SAR) or your electronic FAFSA data. It includes:

- Cost of Attendance or your Budget—the estimated amount that it will cost you to attend Alliant during the nine-month enrollment period (2 semesters).
- Expected Family Contribution (EFC calculated by a federal formula) -- the amount you and your family can contribute to your education based on your FAFSA information
- Financial Need -- your eligibility for need-based aid, such as grants, subsidized Federal Loans, Federal Work Study and some scholarships

Cost of Attendance - EFC = Financial Need

The total financial aid award cannot exceed the cost of attendance.

# Notification

Once we have determined your eligibility (Financial Need) and packaged your financial aid, we produce your financial aid award letter. We use an Electronic Award Letter on the web. You will receive an email notifying you that your Award Letter is available.

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# Accreditation

# **Non-Discrimination Policy**
